Community Alert—BEWARE!!

Beware, a man was apprehended for indecent exposure!

Fire Safety

As temperatures drop and we turn on our furnaces, it is important to keep Coventry safe:

- Remove flammables away from your furnace and hot water tank.
- Examine and clean your dryer vents free from lint buildup. Residents should be cleaning the lint filter after drying each load of laundry. This is good practice to maintain all year long.
- Install/check smoke detectors. Replace the batteries, as needed.
- Wood burning in fireplaces is strictly prohibited per the Amendment to the Master Deed and Bylaws, which passed in 2023. If you know someone is burning, please contact management immediately. All reports are confidential and appreciated to keep Coventry safe!

Daylight Savings Time

When do we "Fall Back" in 2023?

The first Sunday in November is when Daylight Saving Time ends in Michigan this year, so we "fall back" one hour and return to Standard Time on Sunday, November 5, 2023, at 2am.

FALL BACK

Be sure to set your clocks back one hour before bed Saturday night.

NO PARKING OVER SIDEWALKS

Sidewalks are for walking, not parking. Please do not park over the sidewalk. This not only impedes on resident walkways, but interferes with emergency services and snow removal. Avoid a violation and fines. Please do not park over the sidewalks.





Our Coventry Compost Dumpster is NOT for Garbage

The light green, open top dumpster in the clubhouse parking lot is for Coventry compost only: leaves, twigs, flowers, garden plants, weeds, etc. No plastic bags, please. Coventry has to pay extra when material that is not compost is mixed into the contents of our compost dumpster.

Security cameras are focused on Coventry dumpsters and are recording 24 hours every day. Violations will be issued along with fines assessed to owners accounts! Please do not put garbage or inappropriate materials in our recycling dumpsters.

Reminder: A compost Dumpster will be temporarily installed in the back of Wickham for fall clean-up. Same rules apply! **No Garbage!**
