As the year is coming to a close and we prepare for the Holiday season, this is the time that we look back on the accomplishments of the past year. The 2025 budget was sent out recently with the good news that there is no increase in HOA fees this year.

We have been working for the past 2 years to get to the point that we are starting to resemble our tradition of being a self-managed

community. We have our own onsite maintenance staff which creates significant cost savings and also improves response time for dealing with maintenance issues. We have hired a full time Community Manager to handle administrative duties and to interface with co-owners.

Projects undertaken this year include:

- 1. Roof replacement on 5 buildings covering 38 individual units.
- 2. Installed new wiring and conduit on a large section of our post lights in the north section of the property.
- 3. Renovation of the office with fresh paint, new flooring and new furniture.
- 4. Parking lot crack sealing.
- Several major plumbing repairs resulting in a new proactive drain line inspection program to try to -identify any plumbing issues before they result in a flooded basement.
- 6. Purchase of a tractor with front bucket & backhoe.
- 7. Ongoing door replacement program.
- 8. Automated pool chlorination system installed.
- 9. Policy Handbook was revised printed and distributed to all units.

- 12. Purchased new banquet tables for the clubhouse.
- 13. Purchased new picnic tables for the park.
- 14. Upgraded the wi-fi for the clubhouse and pool area.
- 15. Sidewalk lifting and grinding to eliminate trip hazards.
- 16. Installed new wiring & conduit for various light posts.
- 17. Assigned parking has been approved but is still in the design phase. We anticipate rolling it out in the Spring 2025 of once the weather allows us to paint numbers on the curbs.
- 18. Hired a new vendor for Landscaping and snow removal at a significant savings.
- 19. By year end we will have earned approximately \$80,000 in interest on our reserve fund.

It has been a busy year and there is more to come next year.






