PERKS OF HAVING A SALT WATER POOL!

We have converted our Coventry Parkhomes Community pool from chlorine to saltwater!

Converting to a saltwater pool offers several benefits. It is gentler on the skin and eyes compared to chlorine pools, eliminating irritation, dryness, and burns. Saltwater is naturally biocompatible, making it comfortable for swimmers without goggles. Maintenance is also easier, as a salt chlorinator system handles sanitizing with minimal effort. Saltwater pools also have less odor, as they reduce chloramines, the compounds responsible for the strong smell in chlorine pools.

Grab your swimsuit and join your neighbors at the pool this summer, opening in MAY 2025! Be on the lookout for the upcoming email regarding all pool safety information, and the exact date it will be open.
